

Rules

1. The Event will be run under British Riding Clubs Competitions Official Rules 2018. It is the Riders' responsibility to familiarise themselves with these rules.
2. Please note the rules for correct Tack and Riders Attire as per BRC Rulebook 2018. A tack inspection will be carried out for all horses/ponies prior to competing in any class. All hats must be tagged with **AQUA BLUE** BRC tape (available on the day at the secretaries tent).
3. All Horses/Ponies **MUST** have up to date Flu Vaccinations in Line with Jockey Club Rules. Please bring Passports/Flu Certificates to Event. Any Horse/Pony without the correct and valid certificate will be eliminated and not allowed to compete.
4. The Judges' decision is final.
5. All Persons attending the event do so at their own risk. Vale of Arrow Riding Club, its officials and agents cannot be held responsible for any accident, theft, loss, Damage, injury or illness, howsoever caused arising out of or at this competition.
6. All persons attending shall be solely responsible for consequences of loss or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from, any animal and indemnify the Vale of Arrow Riding Club, Officials, Agents and the venue owners against all damages, actions, claims, proceedings, costs and or expense in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the show. Children under 16 must be under adults supervision at all times.
7. Horses or Ponies must be 4 years of age and over.
8. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any class without explanation. The Committee cannot be held responsible for any error in the time schedule and reserve the right to amend/alter/cancel any class.
9. Dogs must be on leads at all times.
- 10. Area 15 Qualifier Teams/Individuals must be declared at least 30 minutes prior to each class commencing.**
11. Health, Safety & Welfare, The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all Officials and Stewards.
12. It is a condition of entry that all the above rules must be complied with.

- All Horse's names as on Passport please, no stable names as Passports will be checked alongside the Flu Vaccination check, prior to any Horse/Pony competing in all qualifying classes
- Team changes made after Thursday 26th July @ 12noon will only be accepted alongside a doctor or vet certificate

REGIONAL QUALIFIER ENTRIES

- All National Qualifier Entries will be included in the selection for the Regional Championships
- **No Prelim Entry needed but** Entry must be made on the BRC Official form to the entries secretary by Friday 20th July clearly marked **REGIONAL**
- **Team Classes Only, not for individuals.**
Teams may be Senior, Junior or Mixed,
- Qualifying Team classes: **A** -Junior Dressage (P7, P13, P14 & N27), **B** - Junior RT, **C** –Senior Dressage (P13), **D** -Senior RT (Prelim RT & Novice RT)
