

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

To be run under British Riding Club Competitions 2018 Official Rules

Flu vaccination passport/certificates must be presented with the horse and will be checked prior to any Horse/Pony competing in a qualifier class. Non-compliance with this rule will incur elimination from the competition but competitors may complete their test at the discretion of the organisers

Tack inspection will be carried out for all horses and ponies before competing in Qualifier classes.

The organiser and its officials and agents cannot be held responsible for any accident, theft, loss or damage however caused arising out of or at the competition.

Each competitor (parent or guardian) shall be solely responsible for consequences of loss or damage done to or occasioned by or arising from any animal and indemnify Cricklands Equestrian Club officials, agents, invitees and the showground owners against all damages, actions, claims, proceedings, costs and or expenses in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the show. Children under 16 years must be under adult supervision at all times.

Refunds prior to the close of entry date will only be given if horse or rider is injured. A veterinary or medical certificate must be produced. No refund whatsoever from the close of postal entries.

Hard hats to BS Standard PAS015 EN1384 or American Standard SEI or ASTM F. Must be worn at all times and be tagged with BRC blue tag – which can be collected from the secretary's tent on the day.

Any objection must be lodged with the secretary within 5 minutes of the end of the class concerned, together with a deposit of £10.00. Returnable if the objection is sustained. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any class without explanation except to the appropriate body.

The committee cannot be held responsible for any error in the time schedule and reserve the right to cancel classes or amend classes or times in any way.

Health and Safety and Welfare: The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accident occurring and obey the instructions of the organiser and all the official stewards.
